Geranium



Pelargoniums, which are more widely known as Geraniums, are one of the easiest flowers to grow. Geraniums are hardy, with a tolerance for full sun positions in the garden and can thrive on very little water supply.

Originating in South Africa, today's varieties come with single flowers and double flowers in many beautiful colours!

Used for their perfume, their essential oil, as medicine and for their ability to brighten up gardens with their range of hues, geraniums are popular all over the world!

Prune them back when they start to get straggly and give them a good feed with an organic fertiliser like our Super Booster. Keep an eye out for all the different varieties - you may even find

the rose or chocolate scented ones!

Top Tip: For continual blooms, dead-head the old flowers as they go brown.
