Feature Farm Ray Eather

- Prune Roses & follow up with a spray of Lime Sulphur.
- Fertilise winter growing vegetables mid-morning with our Super Growth All Purpose Liquid Fertilizer
- Reduce frost injury by gently hosing over plants first thing in the morning. Don't remove frost-damaged sections of plants to provide protection to the still growing plants underneath.
- Prune plants that flowered in summer or autumn
- Prepare your vege patch for spring with some composted manure pellets like Super Booster.


